Sub: Consent letter to Jharsuguda Law College, Jharsuguda, Orissa, regarding enrolment as an advocate being allowed to 14 of it's pass-outs/ students

Sir,

It may be hereby noted that as per a clarification letter of the college dated 24th September, 2016, sent to the Bar Council of India, it was submitted that 35 students were admitted in such college in the 2006-2007 for it's three year LL.B course, which was incidentally it's first batch. The students were admitted, without the college having any approval from the Bar Council of India. Out of aforesaid 35 students of 2006-2007, only 14 students passed the law course of the said college coming under Sambalpur University, in the year 2010 and 2013. Now, the college has closed down


The only prayer of the college was/is that 14 students who had passed the three year LL.B course from the said college, coming under Sambalpur University and had also obtained bonafide certificates, were/are not getting license to practice. It was/is prayed by the college that they may be permitted to obtain the requisite license required to practise

It is hereby intimated to you that the abovesaid matter was considered by The Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 22nd October, 2016. It was principally agreed, therein that as a special case, which is not to be used as a precedent and considering the future of 14 students/pass outs of the said college, they are hereby entitled to be enrolled as an advocate, if other conditions are/were satisfied and only after an amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- which had been deposited by the college for the inspection purposes was/ is adjusted towards the default money payable by the college as per the principle of Justice Kurian Joseph.

A final further letter, may be issued in this regard after approval of the recommendation of the Legal Education Committee, by the Bar Council of India.
